This program trains students in proactive and reactive cybersecurity measures. They learn to identify and prevent potential security vulnerabilities and to respond effectively to incidents by tracking and patching security holes. The curriculum includes seizure and analysis of equipment post-incident, along with comprehensive coverage of network and system security principles, risk management, security architectures, and disaster recovery. Students also prepare for certifications in CompTIA, Network, and Security+, equipping them with essential skills for handling and preventing cyber threats.
