PROJECT COMPLETE

The facility includes both classroom and lab spaces for programs such as Horticulture, Cosmetology, Health Care, Public Safety/Homeland Security/Emergency Medical Services, Childcare, Biomedical Science, Film/Multi-media, Visual Arts. There is also an office space designated to share with Trident Technical College, who will partner instructional services with Wando High, as well as have use of the facility for after-hours instruction. In addition, there is a separate fully equipped 6,000 sf automotive technology facility located at the rear of the campus, as well as a greenhouse and equipment storage building along Warrior way.

PROJECT DATA

Scope: Construction of the New Career & Technology Academy on a 5.2 acre site immediately in front of the existing Wando High School. The 130,000 square foot facility will serve approximately 600 students currently enrolled at Wando High from the District 2 enrollment area.
