



Today

Welcome to Drayton Hall Elementary School located in Charleston, South Carolina. We are a true neighborhood school educating students in Pre-Kindergarten through 5th grade. We have approximately 620 students currently attending our school. Each day, our students and staff use Apple devices to assist with mastery of the South Carolina College and Career Readiness Standards.

In 2010, we implemented our 1:1 iPad program, and since then, we have become a lighthouse technology school for Charleston County Schools. In addition to iPads, our teachers utilize MacBooks for designing and executing daily instruction. Almost all of our teachers are Apple Teacher Certified. Our digital learning culture is built around connection, creation, collaboration and personalization.

Vision

Since having Apple devices in our classrooms, Drayton Hall has transformed, adapted, and grown in numerous ways. Through it all, the one driving idea that has stayed constant is our strong desire to empower staff, students, and stakeholders to explore and embrace technology in all facets of education. We know it is our responsibility to provide the best education possible for our students to succeed in the 21st century, and we believe through creation, collaboration, and leadership, we can meet the needs of all learners. Our technology team, consisting of administrators and teacher-leaders, meets monthly to brainstorm, review, and advance our school-wide technology initiatives. The team continually reflects on best practice through discussion, observations, and artifacts in order to keep Drayton Hall on the forefront of innovation.

Learning

At Drayton Hall, students are encouraged to take knowledge learned from daily classroom instruction and apply it using various creation apps such as Keynote, Book Creator, Pic Collage, Sketches and many more. Creating on the Apple devices provides students the flexibility and accessibility to personalize their learning. Students may choose to record a presentation rather than speaking in front of their class or create a book to show their deep understanding of a topic. We believe creation applications on the Apple devices allow students to embrace "sticky" learning experiences that they will retain for many years to come.

Drayton Hall has measurable learning successes even during the Covid-19 shutdowns thanks to the convenience and limitlessness of the Apple devices. The devices connect our teachers and students, and they support students' learning experiences beyond the school walls. Teachers provide innovative homework alternatives through digital content. They host virtual visits with authors, community workers, and sports teams to support global thinking. Students easily access digital curriculums for a more hands on, engaging learning experience. Functional apps such as Apple Teacher, and Clock/Timers motivate and keep students on track.

We encourage all who enter our building to share and collaborate on innovative project ideas, new Apple apps and reflect on student artifacts. Our students and teachers learn from each other. At Drayton Hall, even our youngest learners are able to safely navigate research paths on their Apple device through guided student and teacher partnerships. As the students move through the grade levels, they are gradually released to create, research, and take full ownership of their learning. These scaffolded collaboration opportunities allow students to meet growth goals at Drayton Hall year after year and enable students to gain necessary career readiness experiences.



This allows all students to become proficient in developmentally appropriate creation application skills, and it will free up more in-class time to create, collaborate and present innovative projects.
