## PROJECT COMPLETE

The new Career and Technical Education building for Baptist Hill High School is complete. The new 16,282 square foot building is designed to provide advanced courses for high school students in the Engineering, Construction and Biomedical fields. In addition, the building provides new classrooms for the JROTC program, including a new outdoor drilling area. The project renovated spaces in the main building for the Barbering and Dance programs and moved the Gateway program into the middle school wing. New fencing was installed to secure the interior courtyard between buildings and a new bus canopy was provided.

**Scope:** Construction of a new 16,282sf building to house 2 PLTW Classrooms, the ROTC program and Building Construction Lab. Renovation of the existing high school to support the barbering, dance and gateway programs.
