Curtis Walker takes over football program at North Charleston High School

North Charleston, SC – The North Charleston High School community welcomes Curtis Walker as its new head football coach. He brings a wealth of coaching experience ranging from Salisbury High School in Salisbury, NC, to Catawba College (also in Salisbury, NC).

Walker coached linebackers and began coordinating all recruiting in 1997 at Catawba College. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2001 where the Chiefs ranked first in Division II in scoring defense and 15th in total defense. He assumed the role of head football coach in 2012. In 2015, he was named the South Atlantic Conference (SAC) Coach of the Year after guiding Catawba College to its first SAC Championship since 2007 and a spot in the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

Walker also served ten years as the defensive coordinator at Coastal Carolina University. While at Coastal Carolina, he helped lead the Chanticleers to four Big South Championships and the NCAA FCS Playoffs.

During his time as a player at Catawba College, Walker was the most valuable player in 1991, served as captain of the team, and was a three-time All-American linebacker. He was inducted into the Catawba Sports Hall of Fame in 2004 and the South Atlantic Conference Hall of Fame in 2008.

Walker is married to LaSheka Foxx Walker. They have two sons – Jalon and Deuce. Jalon is a freshman linebacker at the University of Georgia, and Deuce is a junior wide receiver and defensive back at Salisbury High School.

“We have great expectations of Coach Walker, and we are of the opinion he will be successful in his endeavors at NCHS,” said Principal Henry Darby. “We are proud to have Coach Walker join the Cougar family.”
