CCSD's Board of Trustees selects BWP and Associates for superintendent search

Charleston, SC – Charleston County School District's (CCSD) Board of Trustees will use [BWP and Associates](#) to guide their search for the district's Superintendent of Schools. Earlier this month, they selected the national search firm, which specializes in assisting boards seeking superintendents. Dr. Kevin Castner and Dr. Percy Mack of BWP and Associates will lead the process.

The Board's first step is to identify the characteristics they are looking for in a new superintendent. Part of the process will involve public engagement so the Trustees can do the following:

- Learn the strengths, needs, and issues of the school system to better recruit a slate of candidates that meet the needs of CCSD
- To be able to describe the District's strengths, needs, and issues to the recruited candidates
- To engage in the process in such a way that will build community understanding and support for the search
