**CORPORATE RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION GRANT APPLICATION TO THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES**

The Undersigned Secretary of Goodwin University Educational Services, Inc. hereby certifies that the following resolution was duly adopted by the Board of Directors on May 15, 2024, and that such resolution has not been modified, rescinded or revoked and is at present in full force and effect on the date hereof:

**WHEREAS**, Goodwin University has been working in consultation with the State of Connecticut to establish a new Magnet Technical High School on the Goodwin campus, and

**WHEREAS**, in June 2023, House Bill 6942 authorized the funding of \$75,000,000 to construct said school and established a one hundred percent reimbursement rate, and

**WHEREAS**, in May of 2024, House Bill 5524 authorized an increase in funding to \$85,000,000 to construct the new school and maintained the one hundred percent reimbursement rate, and

**WHEREAS**, a School Construction Grant Application, SCG-1049, and related documents are being prepared for submission to the Connecticut Department of Administrative Services.

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution is in furtherance of the following Focus Area/Goal/Strategy of the approved 2022-25 Strategic Plan: Focus Area 3 – Expanding and reimagining the Goodwin and UB Metropolis/Goal 2 – Develop new markets that lead to financial stability and growth for the combined university system/Strategy 1 – Expand Goodwin University Magnet School System to maximize impact and revenue

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors hereby authorizes the Superintendent to apply to the Commissioner of Administrative Services for a School Construction Grant and accept or reject a grant for the Magnet Technical High School (State Project # 542-TBD MAG/N).
