#### **SCHEDULES**

Will be available at the orientation session on June 13th, at 10 am, in the LVMS gym.

#### **MEALS**

The Lompoc Unified School District will be providing free breakfast AND lunch to all students participating in the summer school program. No application is needed for students and children to receive free meals. *If your child has a food allergy or special medical request, please indicate the request on the registration form.*

#### **ATTENDANCE**

- Regular attendance procedures used during the school year will apply to the summer session. If students do not report to the assigned teachers for the first day of instruction, they will be dropped, and a student from the waiting list will be notified to attend.
- Any student with more than three days of unexcused absences will be dropped from summer school.
- **APEX** students must attend the first day and must attend class to complete assessments.
- All APEX work must be completed by July 12th for credit.
- **Math** students will be enrolled in a 2 hr Math session and **daily attendance is required.**
- Math credit recovery will only be offered for Math 1 and Math 2
- Math students needing both first and second semester of either Math 1 or Math 2 will be referred to in-seat Math next school year. They may complete other courses on APEX during summer school.

#### **Chromebook**

Students will keep their chromebooks for summer school. Seniors will need to check out their device from their homeschool if they are attending summer school.
