# Legal Mandate Requiring Reporting by Volunteers of Arrests, Convictions and Substantiated Child Abuse

### PLEASE KEEP THIS NOTICE

District volunteers are required by law to notify the Northwestern Lehigh School District in writing within 72 hours if they are arrested or convicted of a criminal offense involving child abuse or if the volunteer is named as a perpetrator of an indicated or founded child abuse report. Volunteers must notify Luann E. Matika, Director of Human Resources. The Northwestern Lehigh School District Human Resources Office is located at 6493 Rt.309 New Tripoli, PA 18066.

The written notification to the District includes any and all of the following:

(relating to crimes and offenses) **or convicted of an equivalent crime under the laws or former laws of the United States or one of its territories or possessions, another state, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico or a foreign nation, or under a former law of this Commonwealth.**
