This checklist is intended to help you check off each item as you have it completed by your physician and/or yourself.

1.	Student Emergency Information (Complete as much as possible and remember you <u>must</u>
	have at least 3 working phone numbers of contact persons to call in the event of an emergency or
	illness)
2.	Medical Record Update (This should be completed and signed by your student's
	physician. The information is used to keep your child safe at school and during any emergency as
	well as prepare for your student's IEP/MET)
3.	Seizure Action Plan (If your student has no history of seizures or it has been a long time
	since his/her lasty seizure please indicate that on the form)
4.	Shunt Malfunction Action Plan (If this is not applicable to your student, please disregard
	this form)
5.	Allergy Action Plan (If your student has no history of allergies, please indicate that on the
	form)
6.	Authorization for Medical Procedure Form (If your student is to have medical procedures
	done at school then this <u>must</u> be completed and signed by a physician and renewed annually. All
	procedures can be documented on one form)
7.	Authorization for Medication Form (If your student is to take medication during school
	hours, i.e. prescriptions, over the counter, herbal, this form <u>must</u> be completed and signed by a
	physician before medication can be given at school and renewed annually)
8.	Guardianship Form (If you/a guardian/a care provider have full or partial guardianship of
	your child you <u>must</u> provide the court order)
9.	Authorization for Photographs
10.	Blanket Field Trip Permission Form

Thank you in advance for completing the above thoroughly and accurately. *Please remember that failure to complete and turn in the above forms by the first day of the new school year may put your child at risk of being excluded from activities and/or instruction for their own safety.* We look forward to a safe and healthy school year working with your son/daughter.
