AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the amount of the budget for the current year to be raised by levy taxes of \$15,468,040 be levied and spread upon the taxable property of Cheektowaga-Sloan UFSD at the rate herein before determined and fixed by the Board of Education.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District Clerk of the Cheektowaga-Sloan UFSD prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, file with the Clerk of Erie County Legislature verification of adopting of the tax budget and tax rate.
