

PLAYGROUND USE
Pre-School and Elementary School Buildings

For the safety and security of our preschool and elementary aged school students, the District reserves the right for playgrounds to be used exclusively by District students and staff between the hours of 7:15 a.m. and 6 p.m. on school days and during any school events or activities, regardless of the hour, when the playground and/or site is utilized by the District. **NOTE:** All pets, even when leashed, are prohibited during these times as well. During permissible times, all pets must be on a leash when on or near any school site and all droppings picked-up and disposed of properly.

Individuals may be asked to leave if their use of the playground interferes with school activities, violates Board policy or otherwise conflicts with local or state mandates. Failure to adhere to this guideline may necessitate the involvement of law enforcement.

Community groups may apply for a permit if a school event is not scheduled. Such permits shall specifically reflect the areas and times to be used such as, but not limited to, the playground and basketball courts.

School properties, including playgrounds, are drug-free and weapon-free school zones; therefore, the use of tobacco, alcohol and other drugs as well as possession of any weapon or dangerous instrument that may pose threat or harm to others is strictly prohibited (see Policies 6007, 6008, 6009 and 6003).
