






Project Overview:

Existing classrooms door openings were re-framed in order to make the entrances ADA accessible.

Existing classrooms horizontal unit ventilators have been replaced with new vertical unit ventilators.

Project Overview:

Flooring has been replaced throughout the building, walls are painted, existing doors have been replaced, and all lighting is currently being replaced. New lockers have been installed in corridors.

All bathrooms have been completely renovated. New tile has been installed, fixtures have been replaced, and new lighting installed.

Project Overview:

New LVT flooring, wall pads, and basketball backboards have been installed in the gymnasium.













Project Overview:

New ADA playground equipment has been installed, as well as new exterior basketball poles and backboards. Basketball court asphalt sealcoating is to follow.













Project Overview:

Concrete pads and underground utilities have been placed for the new generator, new switch gear, and new transformer for the building. Foundations have been placed for the new concrete ramp to the gymnasium.
