

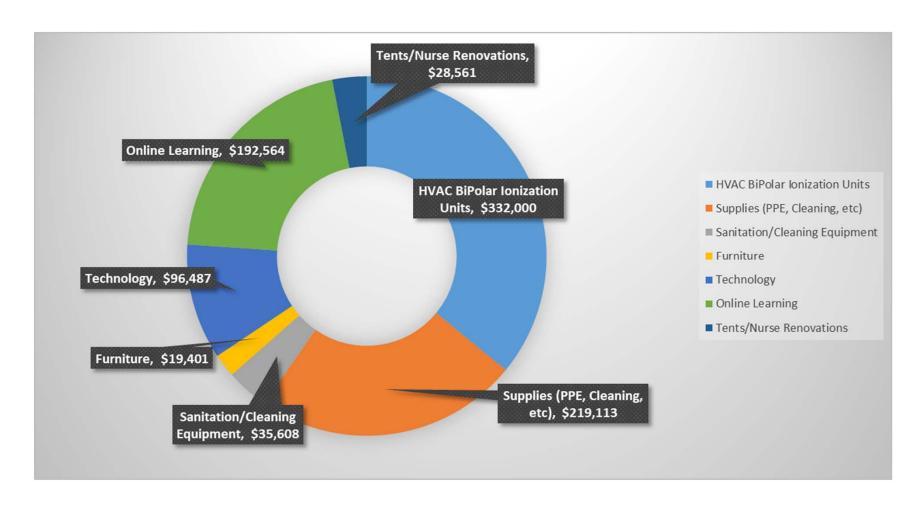

Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Funds

ESSER II

- Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA Act) enacted December 27, 2020
- Funding awarded based on Title I-A (FY 2020) formula
- NWL preliminary award amount \$649,298

ESSER III

- American Rescue Plan (ARP)
 Act of 2021
- Funding awarded based on Title I-A (FY 2020) formula
- 20% set-aside for targeted learning loss
- NWL preliminary award amount \$1,312,408
 - 20% set-aside \$262,482

ESSER Eligible Uses

- Coordinating preparedness and response efforts
- Purchasing supplies to sanitize and clean
- Repairing and improving school facilities
- Improving indoor air quality
- Addressing the needs of children
- Improve the preparedness and response efforts
- Providing meals to eligible students and providing technology for online learning

- Purchasing educational technology
- Providing mental health services and supports
- Summer learning and supplemental after-school programs
- Addressing learning loss
- Other activities that are necessary to maintain operation of and continuity of and services, including continuing to employ existing or hiring new LEA and school staff
