Public Content

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the White Plains City School District publicly advertised and invited sealed proposals for Social Emotional Learning Consultant and Professional Development Services for the 2024 -2025 school year. The proposals were required to be received by April 12, 2024;

AND, WHEREAS, proposals were evaluated on a weighted system established by the District for each of the categories to be reviewed. The evaluation criteria included special knowledge or expertise of the proposer, suitability for the District's needs, proposer credentials and certifications, quality of services to be provided, staffing/time available, and fee schedule as reasonably determined by the District;

AND, WHEREAS, on April 12, 2024, the White Plains City School District received two (2) proposals. The following provider submitted a proposal for Social Emotional Learning Consultant and Professional Development Services at the rates below:

Saint Elizabeth University
Proposed Fee for Services: \$75,000.00
Per School: \$15,000.00, for 5 schools
Hourly Rate: \$ 150.00 - \$ 200.00

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that based on the evaluation criteria established by the District, the Board of Education accepts the proposal and authorizes the Assistant Superintendent for Business to enter into an agreement with Saint Elizabeth University to provide Social Emotional Learning Consultant and Professional Development Services for a contract term of July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025.
