**For your convenience, we provide various payment options. You can make payments onsite with cash, check, credit card, or Apple Pay/tap. Alternatively, you can pay online by visiting <https://dorchester2sc.csiepay.com> and bring the confirmation of your payment when dropping off your child. It's crucial to remember that all payments must be settled before your child can attend camp, and weekly payments are due by Monday before 6:00 p.m. We kindly request parents to inform us of any weekly changes by May 1st to prevent billing issues and guarantee a seamless camp experience for your child. Your timely payments play a significant role in ensuring the smooth operation of the camp, and we appreciate your cooperation in this matter.**

**PICK-UP/AUTHORIZATION** – Your child's safety is our top priority. Pick up and drop off takes place in the Newington Café-Atrium. Please park in the rear parking lot of Newington Elementary. Clear signs will guide you. A responsible adult must sign your child in and out every day. Always carry your Picture ID, and ensure that anyone authorized to pick up your child is listed on the registration form and has a Picture ID. If someone not listed needs to pick up your child, a written note or email from either parent or guardian is required. Please note that the latest pickup time is 6:00 pm. Any pickup after 6:00 pm will incur a \$15 late fee for the first 15 minutes and an additional \$15 for every 15-minute increment.

**SUMMER HEAT-** We recommend you pack your child a frozen and filled water bottle in hand each day. Check and pack your child's sunscreen daily. We recommend spraying your child in the morning before arriving at camp. Children are not permitted to share sunscreen. Please advise staff of any allergies to any sunscreen. **Please send an extra set of clothes to camp in an emergency.**

**LUNCH/SNACK:** School lunch and daily breakfast from 7:30 – 8:00 a.m. are provided on Monday and Friday. Lunch will be between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m., and a snack at 3:00 p.m. Students must bring a bag lunch or **lunch box on field trip days, Tuesday through Thursday. Students may bring extra snacks from home.**

**ELECTRONIC DEVICES—Students are responsible for their own devices daily. Game devices and iPads are to be brought at your own risk; phones are NOT permitted.**

**PARENT UPDATES:** We will provide a parent board inside the atrium for parents to know about the week's activities and any schedule changes. Field trips may change due to inclement weather or high heat index.
