How can we effectively promote and support transformative change in teaching and learning initiatives at the school and classroom level that will close post-pandemic learning gaps?



Planning Process

- Principals were asked to review the last three years of data and identify greatest areas of need as it relates to learning loss post COVID.
- Principals brainstormed how best to accelerate learning to reduce learning gaps with a focus on our Title 1 schools.
- Principals agreed to closely monitor progress and provide data on implementation and outcomes.



Three Areas of Greatest Concern

1. Variability in approaches to teaching and learning
2. Increase learning gaps in math, especially for our marginalized groups
3. Unprecedented increase in social emotional needs and behaviors



Support for Teaching and Learning

- Teachers on Special Assignment (TOSA)
- High Reliability Schools (HRS)
- Multiple Tiered Systems Support Specialists (MTSS)
- Training for guest teachers (STEDI) and support personnel
- Advancement via Individual Determination (AVID)
- Fair & Equitable Grading Practices



Support for Math Learners

- Improving Tier 1 and Tier 2 math instruction, K-12
- Targeted instructional and collaboration coaching for CHS math teachers
- Summer math bridge program (RC schools)



Support for Student Behavior

- Training for TK-8 teachers on how to best integrate academic and social-emotional skills.
