3) Superintendent Report

Superintendent Josh Hurt

- Congratulations to Daniel Glass. Welcome to the Metcalfe County Board of Education.
- Jameah is an excellent example of the good things the students of Metcalfe County Schools are doing.
- Spoke at the Chamber quarterly breakfast about the state of the schools with great achievements to talk about.
- Prom is this Saturday.
- Seven middle school students were selected as Rogers Explorers.

- The middle school hosted an Exhibition of Learning night. MCMS students displayed many impressive works.
- Thanks to everyone who made the solar eclipse a great experience for students and staff. The district purchased safety glasses for everyone in the district. Our shipment was short about 400 glasses. A big thanks to Adair County High School, Bank of Columbia, and the Monroe County Library for donating more than enough glasses to make up the difference.
- Folks from OEA – the Office of Education Accountability – were in the district today. The team was conducting statewide research. We talked about the successes and challenges here at Metcalfe County Schools.
- Item 5C will allow us to sell the property at 109 Sartin Drive, where the old Central Office used to be. Currently, the district leases the property.


