Our History...

- Began in 1996 consortium
- Unincorporated LA County, about 61 miles North from Los Angeles
- Fields alfalfa, produce (onions, carrots, potatoes, grapes, peaches, pomegranates, olives) nuts, honey, dairy farms, sod, nurseries, meat processing factory
- Once over 1500 students qualified
- Eligibility based on movement and eligible work
- Child must move with the family
- Eligible for three years






Why We Do This...
