

Florence 1 Schools Child Find

Florence 1 Schools (F1S) has procedures in place to assist families and community entities in providing a continuous process of screening and evaluation designed to locate, identify, and evaluate all children residing in the school district with disabilities

who may be in need of special education and related services. This program includes all children ages 3 to 21, who are not enrolled in Florence 1 Schools already.

Child Find is a component of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) that requires states to identify, locate, and evaluate children with disabilities, regardless of the severity of their disabilities, who may be in need of special education services.

What should I bring to the appointment?

•Bring any recent private evaluations not already provided

•Any paperwork or forms emailed/mailed to you after scheduling your appointment

How long is the screening appointment?

• Initial appointments last approximately 30 minutes.

Where are Child Find Screenings conducted?

• Screenings for preschool-age children are conducted at Woods Road Child Development Center.

What happens after my initial Child Find appointment?

• A team of Child Find evaluators will provide you with the next steps following your appointment based on your child's individual needs.

• Possible next steps could include recommendations or a follow up Child Find appointment for further evaluation.
