



READING PLUS SUMMER READING



A high-quality summer learning solution can minimize and even prevent the loss of reading achievement. Scientific studies show that students may lose up to two months of reading gains during the summer break. An effective summer solution can bridge that gap. Reading Plus® may prevent the summer reading loss, ensuring students return to school ready to move ahead to grade-level literacy.

Your child can complete Reading Plus assignments on your home computer or tablet during the summer. It is recommended students complete **at least 3 SeeReaders each week**. The program will keep track of finished assignments each week during the summer. Weekly assignments reset every Sunday night at 11:59 pm, so students can work on completing assignments over the weekend. Completing Reading Plus assignments over the summer is optional but the program can be very beneficial for your student's reading fluency and comprehension. Students can complete assignments in the Reading Plus program beginning on **Monday, May 20th through Sunday, June 30th**.
Reading Plus will NOT be available during the month of July.

For those students who complete **15 SeeReaders** during the summer, they will receive a gift card to **Bruster's Ice Cream** at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year. Please use the Reading Plus *SeeReader* Tracking Sheet (on the back of this sheet) to keep track of the completed *SeeReaders* along with the individual scores.

How to Check Your Child's Work:
