Strategic Plan Goal:
Outcome: a. Increased percentage of students demonstrating proficiency on standards.
Academic Gap Goal: 4th and 5th grade Hispanic students increase low risk reading proficiency by 10% as measured in reading comprehension from fall to spring on the EasyCBM reading comprehension benchmark.

Indicators of Progress:
 Increased scores for both 4th and 5th grade based on winter benchmarking. 4th showed an increase of 4%, while 5th showed an increase of 8%.

Concern Area:
 Significant growth occurred in both grade levels; however, 4th grade will continue to need to show a lot of growth to meet goal by the end of the year.

Next Steps:
 In addition to continuing with progress monitoring and walk to read groups, we will use March conferences to re-engage families with the home reading log started at the beginning of the year. For some students, we will also use the online Lexia program as a tool for them to gain additional practice at home.

Strategic Plan Goal:
Strategic Plan Goal: 2: Responsible, Resilient, Empowered Learners
Outcome: b: increase in the percentage of regular school attenders.
Behavioral or SEL Gap Goal: Horizons will increase the percentage of regular attenders from 41% to 55% for 2023-2024.

Indicators of Progress:
Regular attendance at Horizons has increased 5% from this time last year. Chronic absences have dropped by 8% in the same time period.

Concern Area:
 We are excited about the jump in regular attenders at HES, but still need to experience major growth to achieve our goal by the end of the year.

Next Steps:
 Having the admin team and school counselor present at spring conferences, continuing to use family communications from the school and individual teachers to emphasize attendance, and regular celebration of attendance will be key factors in continuing our positive attendance growth.
