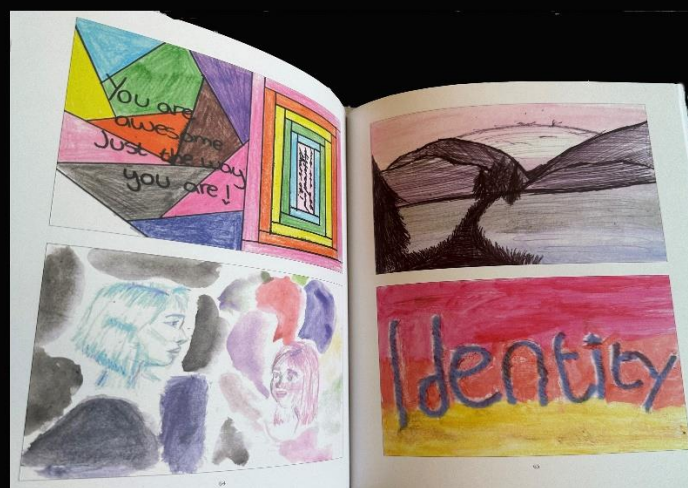
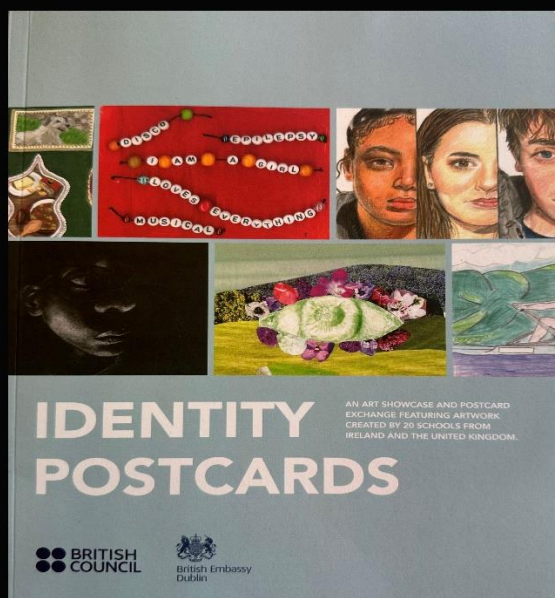

After a series of impressive performances, Bilton School emerged as the overall winner of the competition, securing the top position with their exceptional display of talent and dedication.

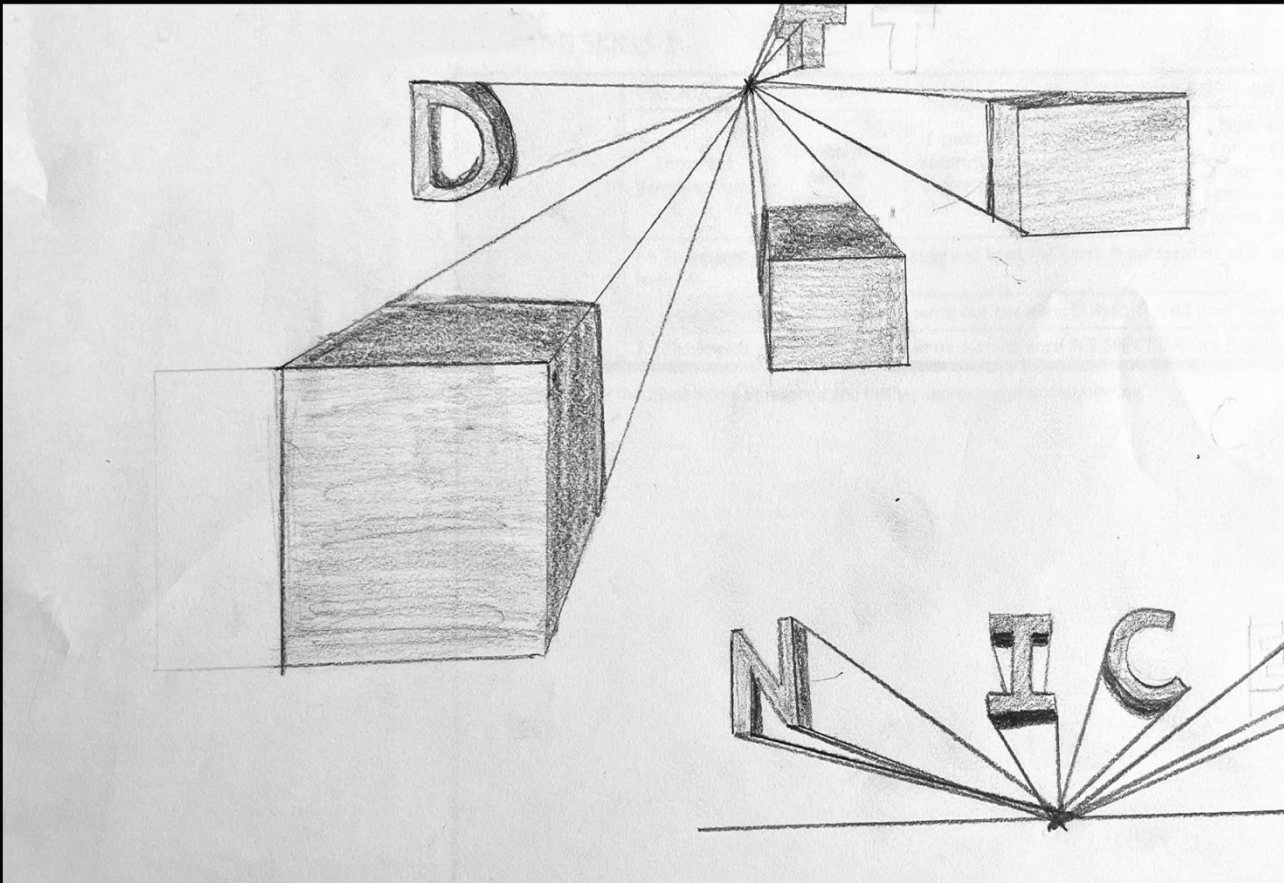
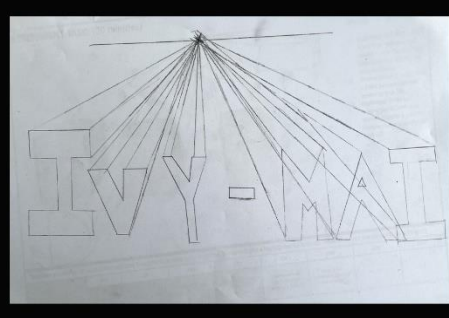
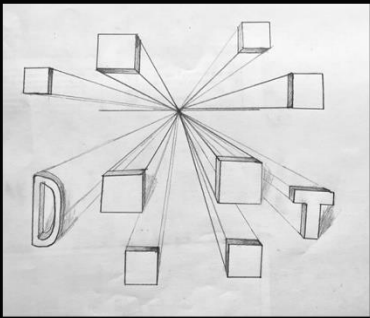
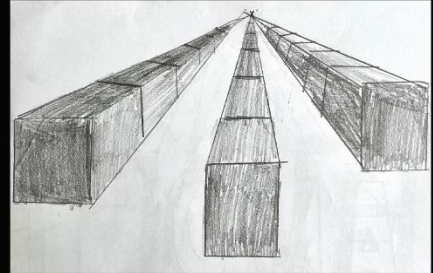
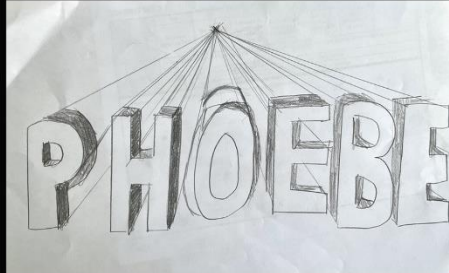
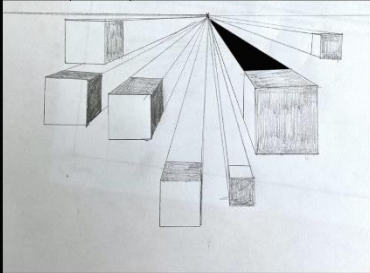

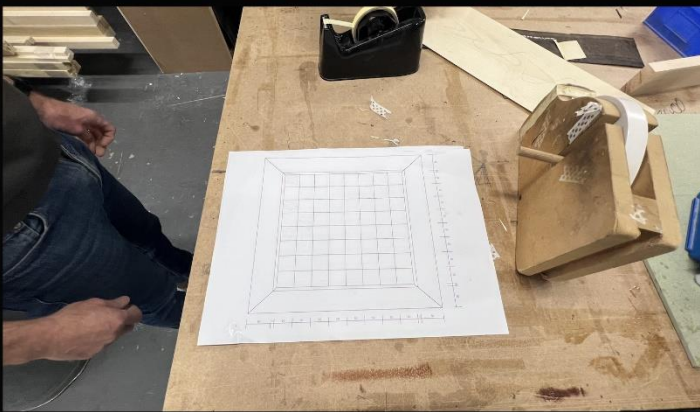
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## Work Experience

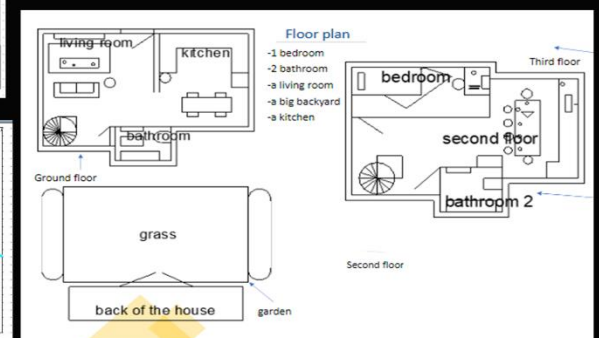
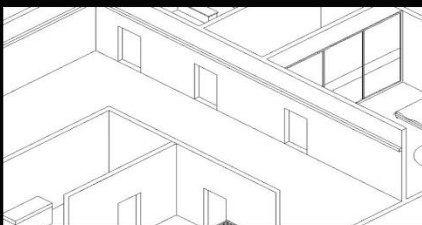
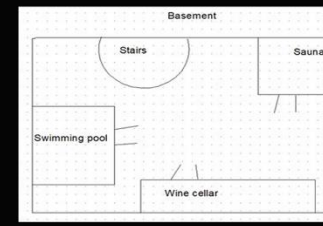
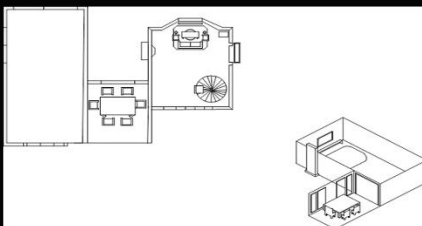
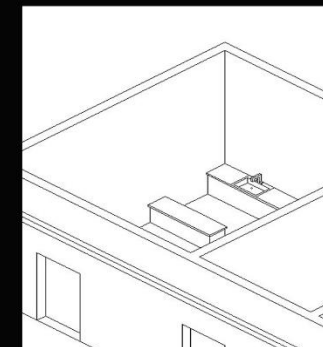
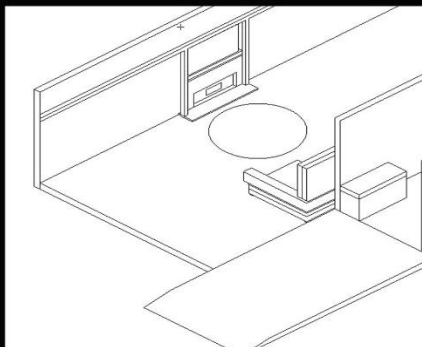
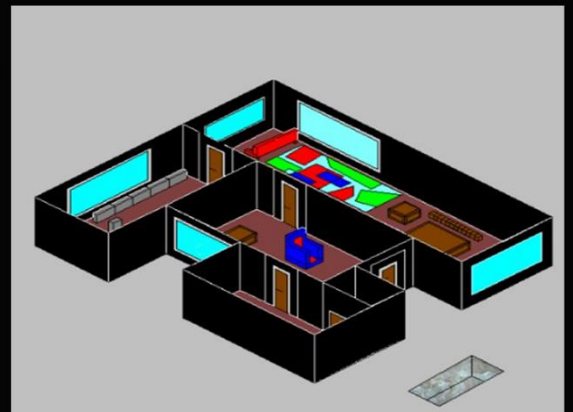
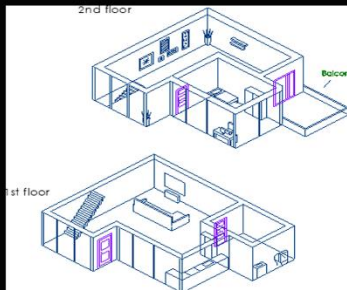
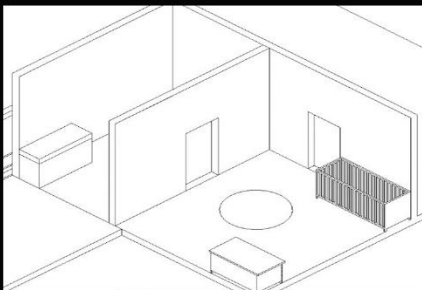
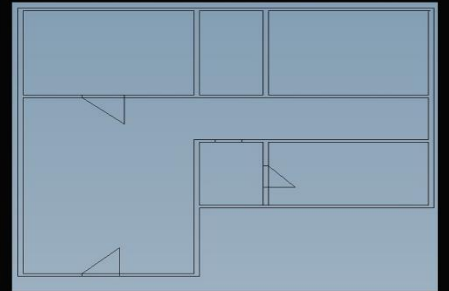
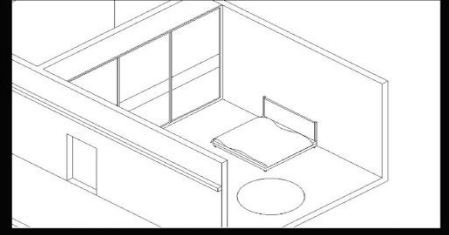
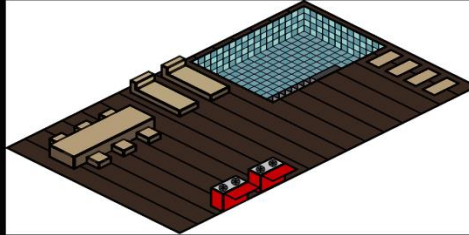
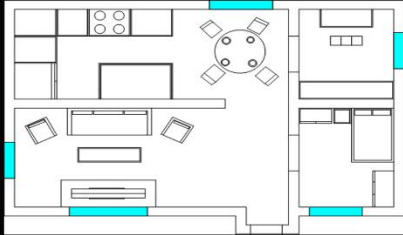
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## YEAR 9 TECHNOLOGY
