Earned B.S. in chemical engineering from Penn State Univ.; Elected to three honor societies; Named Outstanding Graduate in Chemical Engineering.

Awarded a fellowship by Mobil to attend the Univ. of Delaware to earn his PhD in 1974 - PhD thesis addressed fundamental technical issues in catalytic mufflers prior to their worldwide use in automobiles to remove harmful emissions.

33-year career in research at Mobil where he developed new and improved processes for producing high quality, clean-burning fuels from crude oil. Awarded 17 US patents and authored 20 scientific and engineering papers.

Taught engineering to seniors at Penn State Univ. before serving 8 years as Princeton University's Associate Dean for the School of Engineering and Applied Science; Culminated his career by teaching 6 years in the University of Delaware's Honors Program.

Served 6 years on Penn State University's Industrial Professional Advisory Council and 12 years as Adjunct Professor.

Elected as a Fellow of the American Institute of Chemical Engineering; Served as Secretary, Director, and Chair of the Catalysis Society of Metropolitan New York; Served as Commissioner for the Accreditation Board for Engineering Technology; Made accreditation visits to 21 US universities and two universities in Doha, Qatar.
