- 5. Required criminal history background check and proof of U.S. citizenship or legal resident alien status

REPORTS TO: Principal and Supervisor of Bilingual/ESL

SUPERVISES: Students, and when assigned, student teachers

JOB GOAL:

- 1. To support ESL students in need of foundational language and academic skills
- 2. To support the school's ESL instructional program
- 3. To support teaching staff and classroom aides in effective implementation of ESL strategies

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

Student Support

• Provide intensive bilingual/ESL support to SIFE (students with interrupted formal education) and other linguistically low performing ESL students in need of intervention

Administrator Support

- Assist in continual examination and implementation of ESL Curricula
- Assist in coordinating instructional materials and resources for the ESL Program
- Assist in coordinating and/or providing school level professional development sessions
- Assist with school level testing coordinating duties such as ACCESS, iReady, Benchmark Assessments, NJSLS-Assessments
- Assist in identifying and developing course of action to service at-risk ESL students through programs such as Basic Skills, I&RS, and RTI
- Assist in compiling appropriate ESL data to gauge program effectiveness

Teacher Support

- Provide training, coaching, and on-going in-classroom support to staff in the following areas:
 - Implementing effective SEI (Sheltered English Instruction) and Newcomer instructional strategies in content areas as required for at-risk, special education and mainstream ESL students
 - o Using data to inform instruction such as ACCESS, WIDA Can Do Descriptors, iReady, Benchmark, and other formative assessments appropriate to grade level

Other

- Upholds and enforces school rules, administrative regulations and board policy
