

EXPLANATORY TEXT
REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT NO.14
2024-2025 BUDGET REFERENDUM
June 4, 2024

A referendum will be held on **Tuesday June 4, 2024**, in the Towns of Bethlehem and Woodbury with respect to the adoption of a budget for **Regional School District No. 14** [“the District”] for the 2024-2025 fiscal year. Specifically, eligible voters in the District’s afore-mentioned member towns will be voting whether to approve an operating budget for the District for the **2024-2025** fiscal year (which commences on July 1, 2024 and ends on June 30, 2025) in the amount of **\$41,486,051**.

The proposed budget (as amended) represents a **three point three-three percent (3.33%)** increase over the 2023-2024 operating budget. The breakdown of the proposed budget (as amended) is as follows:

- Certified Salaries = 44.67%
- Classified Salaries = 12.46%
- Employee Benefits = 14.38%
- Purchased Services – Non Instructional = 10.75%
- Purchased Services – Instructional = 6.80%
- Debt Service& Liability Insurance = 7.24%
- Capital Outlay = .68%
- Supplies & Materials – Instructional = 1.59%
- Supplies & Materials – Non Instructional = 1.43%

The proposed budget was initially developed by the District’s Superintendent of Schools, with the input of District staff. The District’s Board of Education then received, reviewed, and revised the proposed budget, with presentations to the Board, member town officials and the public at large, including budget workshops and a public hearing. Following the rejection of a budget at a prior referendum, the District’s Board of Education voted to approve an amended budget on May 16, 2024, with this budget now being subject to approval of the voters at the June 4, 2024 referendum. This budgetary review and approval/amendment process is governed by state statutory timelines and mandates. The full proposed budget is available at <https://www.ctreg14.org/district/budget>

The vote on said budget will be by the voting machines in the towns of Bethlehem and Woodbury, Connecticut on Tuesday June 4, 2024 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
