**Pupil recognition is an important part of our behaviour for learning strategy.**

At Pound Hill Infant Academy, we believe that positive and effective behaviour is essential to support our pupil's development; instilling a knowledge of the UOBAT Values and 'Academy behaviours'. This forms part of the academy's [PHIA Behaviour for Learning Policy](#).

**Daily recognition linked to the academy behaviours:**

**Tokens - Individual recognition tokens linked to academy 'behaviours'** Any child who is awarded a token will place it in their class jar, which when full, the class will take be rewarded with a recognition activity as voted by the class. **Going for Gold tokens** Awarded by a member of the SLT.



**Individual recognition Stickers - A** child will be awarded a sticker when a member of staff identifies exceptional learning, behaviour, progress or achievement. The colour of the stickers relates to our academy behaviours. Wearing a sticker home enables the joy of this achievement to be shared at home.



**Going for Gold stickers:** Awarded by a member of staff for exceptional achievement. This may be shared with a member of the SLT who will award the child with a sticker, their name will be added to the 'Golden Book'.

**Daily Role Model:** One child per class, per day will be awarded this for achieving their very best, demonstrating the academy behaviours and/or shining through the academy day. The daily Role Model will wear a Role Model badge for the day.



**Recognition in Assemblies:**

To recognise an individual child's achievement in the academy linked to pro-social/learning behaviours, trust values and academy behaviours:

**Weekly Celebration Assemblies:** One child per class, per week will be awarded a 'value' star by their class teacher. This star will be displayed on the values board, notified in the academy weekly newsletter and the reasoning shared via email with their parents/carers.

**Termly Going for Gold Award:** This is a termly award, recognised with a Gold certificate, the recipient's photo on the Going for Gold noticeboard and their parents invited to the termly assembly, so they can share in this celebration.

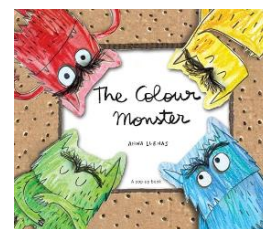
