Dear Parents, Guardians and/or Students, We will not be offering the Traditional Class again this summer. We are still offering the online course if you go to our website: www.TheDrivingCenterOnline.net. Click the get started button to begin your registration. We have the course set up where you can begin and complete up to 50% before it comes to a stop, if you have not made any payment by that point. This is a great time to knock out the online portion of Driver Education. The cost of Driver Education is \$375 for the 30 hours of classroom and 6 hours of behind the wheel instruction with a certified instructor. Our instructors are also certified by the State of Indiana to administer the final behind the wheel drive test. This service is an additional \$30 fee. In order to obtain a learner's permit, you must be at least 15 years of age and enrolled in a driver education class. Once you either pay the \$100 deposit or the full \$375, we would issue the CDE (Certificate of Driver Education Enrollment) form the BMV needs for the student to take the 50 question knowledge exam and obtain the Learners Permit. The behind the wheel drives will be done locally by Mrs. Marianne Milam and Mr. Dave Martz among others. If you have any questions, please feel free to give us a call


