This year our school received supplemental funds from Title 1, a federally funded program, to support student achievement. Here's how we spent some of our money:

**Ground Education:** Students in grades K-5 participated in Ground Education, a weekly program in which students learned about science in our outdoor garden. Students learned about composting, climate change and water conservation. They ate fresh fruit, planted root vegetables and made bird nests. They pet chicks, learned about life cycles of butterflies, food chains and made connections to math by exploring numbers in nature. Ground Education was definitely money well spent.

**Conga Kids:** 5th Grade students participated in Conga Kids. The Conga Kids Mission is to Promote Social and Emotional Well-Being Through Social Dance. Students learned dances of many cultures and generations.

**Summit K-12:** Our EL students received designated ELD instruction using the Summit K12 program, an online, standard-based curriculum that supports language development in reading, writing, listening and speaking.
