- ★ Union General John A. Logan declared the day an occasion to decorate the graves of Civil War soldiers
- ★ Twenty years later, the name was changed to Memorial Day
- ★ President Richard M. Nixon declared Memorial Day a federal holiday in 1971



Ascension of the Lord

ASCENSION: the act of rising to a higher level.

The Ascension of the Lord takes place forty days after the resurrection of Jesus (Easter). Just as on the day left on a Thursday, but the celebration transferred to the following Sunday. On this day, Jesus was taken up to Heaven in his resurrected body in the presence of his apostles.

BIBLICAL REFERENCES

- While he was blessing them, he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven. Luke 24:51
- So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God. Mark 16:19

As the apostles were watching, Jesus was lifted up and a cloud took him out of their sight. While he was going and they were gazing up toward heaven, suddenly two men in white robes stood by them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up toward heaven? The Jesus who has been taken up from you, this human, will come in the same way as you have seen him go into heaven." Acts 1:9-11

The ascension was witnessed in the New Testament in the Apostle's Creed. "He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father."

By the ascension, the Holy Spirit came upon the apostles, and the Holy Spirit descended upon them. Jesus' ascension is the final step in his journey to the Father.
