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INSTRUCTION

Evaluation of Instructional Programs

- I. Each school in the Cambrian School District will submit to the Superintendent or designee a Single Plan for Student Achievement. The Plan will be made available to interested parents, employees, Home and School Clubs, and the public.
 - A. The Single Plan for Student Achievement will be based upon available data that shall include but not be limited to:
 1. District and state academic assessments,
 2. District standards and courses of study,
 3. Standardized tests,
 4. Parent, teacher, student surveys,
 5. Teacher, administrator perceptions,
 6. Physical fitness tests,
 7. School goals, and
 8. District priorities/goals
 - B. Plans will include:
 1. Objectives based upon the conclusions reached through analysis of the above data;
 2. Activities planned to accomplish the objectives;
 3. Responsible person assigned to carry out and monitor progress toward the objectives;
 4. Methods used to measure the attainment of the objectives, and
 5. A time-line and budget to guide the above activities.

II. The Board will annually review instructional programs that will include but are not limited to the following areas: math, middle school update, science/physical, technology, social studies, special education, music/the arts, annual site reports, and literacy. The following questions will be addressed during these program reviews:

- A. What are the goals and focused efforts of the program?
- B. What are we doing to ensure that we meet the goals of the program?
- C. What are the instructional materials used in the program?
- D. How do we know if we are meeting the goals of the program?
- E. What have we accomplished and/or changed since the last annual discussion?
- F. What are our future plans?
