**Procedures to Determine RTI Instructional Need for Services and Discontinuance of Services**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· State Assessments ELA and Math (3-6)</li><li>· STAR Assessments (1-6)</li><li>· Teacher Recommendations Based on Local Assessments (K-6)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· Tier 3: Students scoring at a level 1 on the NYS or STAR ELA or Math Assessments and/or having an overall average of 1 on local assessments</li><li>· Tier 2: Students below the level 2 cut off range (as determined by the state/principal) on the NYS or STAR ELA and/or Math assessments or recommended by classroom teacher based on overall performance on local assessments</li></ul>	<p>The student must score at or above proficiency on the next STAR assessment in order to qualify for discontinuation. In addition, if the student is struggling on local assessments, student must receive three consecutive passing scores on the assessments before being discontinued. A RTI meeting must take place with the RTI team, classroom teacher and principal to determine the student is ready to be discontinued.</p>

Tier 3: ELA and/or math instruction is provided by a literacy/math specialist

Tier 2: ELA and Math services are provided by certified teachers through small group, skill specific instruction and computer assisted instruction
