## Early Dismissals

- Elementary students are dismissed early each Wednesday to provide planning and staff development time for teachers.

- All students will be dismissed early (secondary first, then elementary) on October 4, November 8, January 31, February 14 and April 17.

- All students will be dismissed early the last 3 days\* of school.

\* Official notification of these days at the end of the year and whether they will be scheduled as early dismissal will be determined as soon as possible after the inclement weather season.

## Incent Weather Make-up Days:

Incent weather make-up days will be used in the following order:

- 1: April 22, 2025
- 2: May 23, 2025
- 3: June 16\*\*, 2025
- 4: June 17\*\*, 2025
- 5: June 18\*\*, 2025

\*\*If not used as inclement weather make-up day, schools will be closed for students; professional day for staff.

If the total number of days missed exceeds the designated number of inclement weather make-up days, then virtual education will be utilized at the end of the school year to satisfy state requirements.
