Charles County Public Schools is excited to invite you to participate in our summer Professional Development opportunities for educators.

This summer, we are offering workshops in key instructional areas for teachers and administrators. Some workshops are also targeted for instructional assistants. Please read carefully to determine which sessions apply to your interests and position. Full descriptions and course contacts are found in PowerSchool.

Mandatory Trainings are highlighted in yellow.

Many CCPS workshops offer a stipend. Participants must complete the entire workshop to be eligible for credit or stipend. Workshops that offer a stipend will be clearly marked and normally include the certificated pay amount. The stipend for salaried IAs will be adjusted to \$17 per hour and the stipend for hourly or temporary IAs will be adjusted to \$16.25 per hour. Mandatory training pay will be distributed in late fall.
