Kindergarten: Oral Health Assessment Form is Due May 31

California law requires that students enrolled in kindergarten receive an oral health assessment by a licensed dental health professional, and submit a completed <u>Oral Health</u> <u>Assessment Form</u> to the child's school. Oral health assessments must occur between 12 months prior to the start of Kindergarten and the end of the Kindergarten year on May 31. To fulfill the requirement, please complete and submit this <u>Oral Health Assessment</u> <u>Form</u>, as follows. Parent/guardian must complete:

- Section #1. Licensed dental professional must fill out and sign or stamp
- Section #2. Parent/guardian must return the completed form to the St. John's Health Office by Friday, May 31. To claim an exemption from this requirement, parent/guardian must complete Section #3 and return to the Health Office by Friday, May 31.

St. John's First Math Olympiad Team Represents!

Since 1979, Math Olympiads for Middle Schools has been providing challenging and thought provoking mathematical problems designed to strengthen student's mathematical skills. The SJES Math Olympiad team participated in 5 math contests this year, competing against 90,000 middle school students in all 50 states and 30 foreign countries. SJES's first Math Olympiad team members were Irene Lee, Zackery Mulroy, Richard Shen, Tony Sun, Brody Tilton, Cole Toffer, Athena Tran, Jason Tse, Kaylin Wang, and Remi Wang.

The team members practiced challenging math problems twice a week all year and our practice paid off. All of our team members finished in the **top 50 percent** of competitors!
