Drop-Off Flow

 - Mrs. Dawn Wood will be collecting.
- No parents will be permitted to park for an extended time in the parking lots or spaces



Pick-Up Flow

- Camp ends promptly at 2:00 PM
- Follow the **YELLOW** arrows
- All campers will be outside on the sidewalk in front of the school to be picked up.
 - If raining, ensure your child has the proper rain attire as all campers will be outside.

What time?	8:30 AM - 2:00 PM <i>Day 1 Arrival: 8:15 AM</i>
What is the daily schedule?	AM Session: 8:30 - 11:00 AM Lunch: 11:00 - 11:30 AM PM Session 11:30 - 2:00 PM
Is transportation provided?	No, transportation will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the enrolled student.
Is lunch provided?	Yes, lunch is provided for all students, although students are permitted to bring their own lunch. Additionally, there will be vending machines available. Please note any food or environmental allergies on your child's application.
How can a student be eligible?	Students that have completed 4th, 5th, 6th, or 7th grade from any of our 12 sending districts are welcome to attend free of charge.
What is the dress code?	All programs require different dress codes. Please refer to the "Dress Code Requirements" sheet. It is essential for all students who attend the camp to wear the appropriate attire; otherwise they will not be able to perform certain tasks.
What programs will be offered?	Please refer to the Google Form Registration for specific program availability & activities. (Programs are subject to availability)
How many programs can a student take?	Students will choose two (2) programs. They will attend one of the programs on day 1 of the camp and the other on the second day.
How many students will be in a class?	There will be a 10:1 Student to Teacher ratio. Program availability is on a "first come-first serve" basis. (Additional instructors may be added for demanding programs and programs with low enrollment may be cancelled)
