POINTS OF CELEBRATION



- For three years in a row, Bluffsview has received 5 out of 5 stars in the Gap Closing category, including 3 out of 3 stars for gifted services and having surpassed goals set by the state for all subgroup areas in both math and literacy.
- Passing rates for Ohio State Tests increased dramatically in many areas: 3rd grade math grew from 84% to 91% passing, 4th grade ELA grew from 81.7% to 90.4% passing, 5th grade science grew from 83.7% to 89.7% passing; and both 5th grade math and ELA saw higher levels of growth than in past years.
- Panorama results continue to show that students rate Bluffsview in the 80-99 percentile compared to national schools in all areas (rigorous expectations, school safety, sense of belonging, teacher-student relationships and self-efficacy).

Strategies:

Reading

Work on the top of Scarborough's rope language processing/comprehension strategies to better align comprehension and writing activities to evidence based, standards driven strategies.

Writing

Ensure students learn to use specific techniques that are aligned to different purposes of writing, including using exemplars to model and increase elaboration within the grade and vertically.

Mathematics

Implement instructional environments (math workshop, "thinking classrooms") that allow for differentiation, student engagement, rich mathematical discourse, and scaffolds/supports with a focus on creative strategies for enrichment.

Strategies:

Ensure tier one practices are in place to proactively teach and build student ownership and agency around student's behavioral and emotional regulation skills, teachers will utilize building resources, including school counselors and mental health specialists to assess needs and develop strengths-based interventions. XSEL room will be implemented to give students a place and time to grow these skills.
