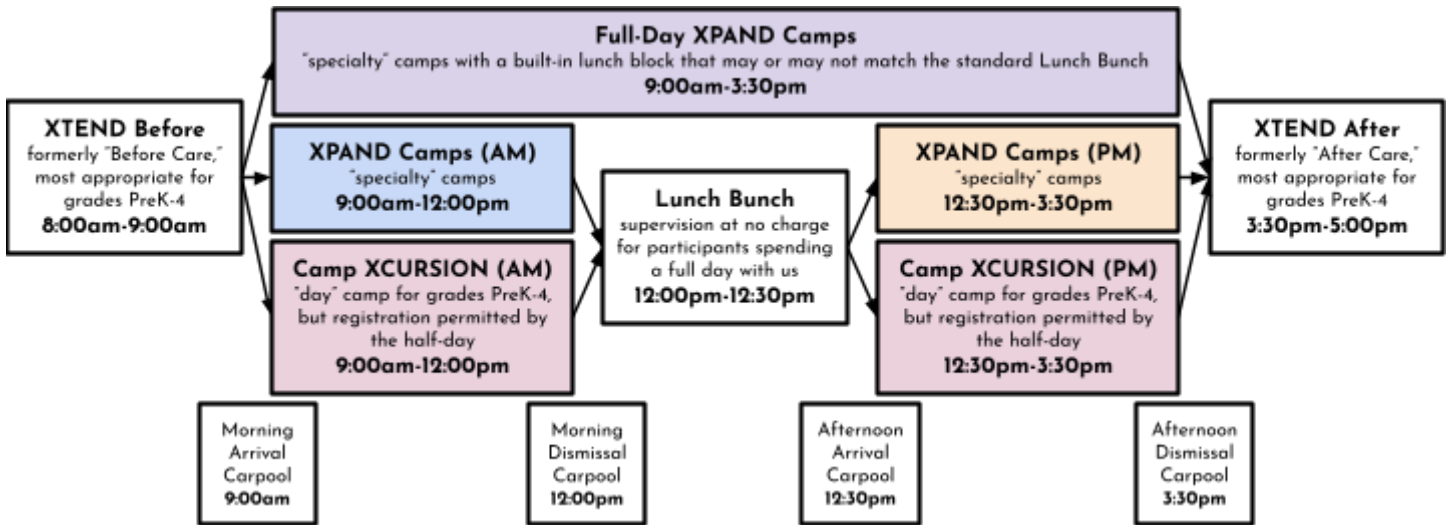
It is our foremost priority to keep all participants **physically** safe while on campus for the summer. To do this we have:

- ❖ trained XPLORE administrators in Youth Mental Health First Aid.

Please note that a very small group of camps and programs are **only open to registered TVS students**. These are listed on [pp. 39-40](#) of this Catalog. Rosters will be cross-checked with Trinity Valley School enrollment records prior to each camp or program start date.

– General Summer 2024 Logistics –

- Most camps will run for one week.
 - For half-day XPAND Camps and Camp XCURSION, the morning session is **9am-12pm** and the afternoon session is **12:30-3:30pm**.
 - Our full-day XPAND Camps will run **9am-3:30pm**, with a built-in lunch block that may or may not match the standard Lunch Bunch.
 - *Certain camps - denoted in this Catalog - will follow nontraditional scheduling.*
 - There will be a supervised 30-minute Lunch Bunch each day, for campers attending both morning and afternoon camps. Supervision is free of charge!
 - There will be a supervised XTEND Before (formerly "Before Care") at **8-9am** each day, for families who need to drop off earlier than the morning session start time. There is a \$5 / day fee for this service.
 - There will be a supervised XTEND After (formerly "After Care") at **3:30-5pm each day**, for families who need to pick up later than the afternoon session end time. There is a \$7.50 / day fee for this service.

- **XPLORE: Summer at TVS** honors the following holidays. No **XPLORE: Summer at TVS** camps or programs will run on these dates.
 - May 27, 2024 (Memorial Day)
 - June 19, 2024 (Juneteenth)
 - July 1-5, 2024 (Independence Day: full-week holiday for campers and staff)

 - **June 21, 2024 at 11:59pm** → Registration will close for all camps in Weeks 6-9 (July 8-August 2).

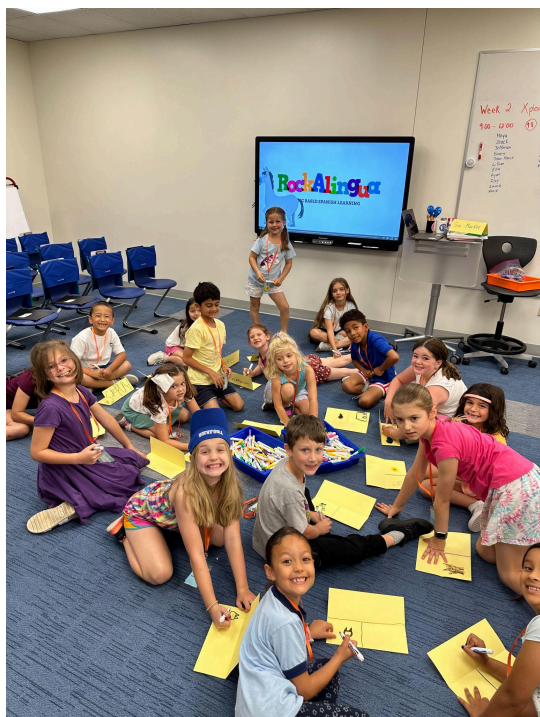

– Summer 2024 “Fine Print” –

- We will use the Auxiliary Programs registration platform for program registration, billing, and en mass family communications.
- It is **required** for each family to have a profile in our system and current / valid credit card information loaded onto the site, so that any new charges and refunds may automatically be processed.
- A note on broadly applicable policies:
 - During the registration process, families will be **required** to agree with the 2024 XPLORE waivers and releases. A copy of these waivers and releases may be found [here](#).
 - One of these waivers is the current **XPLORE: Summer at TVS** Cancellation + Transfer Policy. A copy of this policy may be found [here](#).
 - Some of our programs will use technology to enrich the camper experience. All instructors, interns, counselors, and campers are bound by the current XPLORE Technology Responsible Use Policy, which may be found [here](#).
 - English is the primary language of instruction, including in our foreign language- / culture-based programs. For their safety, we require that all participants **understand verbal communication from instructors and staff**; additionally, some instructors incorporate age-appropriate, literacy-based activities into their programs.
 - It is essential that all participants **know their first and last name**. Participants in grades PreK-8 will receive identification at the beginning of each day, and our team uses participant names frequently, e.g. roster reconciliation during carpool times, identification of Lunch Bunch and XTEND After groups (as applicable), and any medical needs.
- All campers must be 4 years of age or older by the start of the summer season (May 28, 2024).
 - An exception will be made for admitted incoming TVS PreKindergarten students. *Per Admissions policy, TVS PreKindergarten students must turn 4 years old by June 30, 2024. Thus, it is permissible for a 3-year-old to attend appropriate camps in the month of June, **as long as they have been admitted to TVS PreKindergarten for the 2024-2025 school year.***
 - Our camps are designed for **rising** PreKindergarten through **rising** Grade 12 participants. We are unable to admit high school alumni into our programs.
- Regardless of age, it is absolutely essential that all campers are able to use the restroom independently for the duration of their participation in **XPLORE: Summer at TVS** programming.
 - This independence must include basic functions, proper toilet-flushing, and hand-washing skills.
 - Whereas we will certainly respect the dignity of all campers and their families, any camper that is found not to be independent in the restroom will be unregistered from remaining camps for the summer.
