PRESENTATION ON PROPOSED 2024-2025 BUDGET

Brian Sirianni, Assistant Superintendent for Business presented the financial information for proposed 2024-2025 Budget. He discussed the total budget and various specific expenditure areas. He reviewed revenues and taxes.

Dr. Gianleo Duca, Superintendent discussed programming and staffing. He discussed in detail the staffing reductions. He then reviewed the District Goals and how the budget will help achieve the goals.

Discussion

Holly Barker-Flynn asked about the reduction in force process. Dr. Duca outlined the Preferred Eligibility list.

Julia Routbort Baskin stated she was appreciative of the presentation, and asked to discuss the impact on class size due to RIF. Dr. Duca noted that there will be no significant class size increases

Lawrence Ryan added that he calculated 19.5 students per teachers elementary, 24 students per teacher secondary

Katie Whittemore asked if the numbers are based on current enrollment and if there is a downward trend. Dr. Duca confirmed.

Dr. Routbort Baskin asked how long has the downward enrollment trend been going on. Dr. Duca noted that since about 2012.

Cassandra Sacci, Ballston Spa, remarked about the reductions in force, and asked about other Districts adding staff. She shared thoughts on class sizes.
