Executive Board Governance and Operations

Executive Board Operational Goals

The Executive Board's primary responsibility is to establish those purposes, programs, and procedures which will best produce the educational achievement needed by District students within the directives and policies of the Governing Board. It is charged with accomplishing this while also being responsible for wise management of resources available to the District. The Executive Board must fulfill these responsibilities by functioning primarily as a legislative body to formulate and adopt policy, by selecting a superintendent to implement policy, and by evaluating the results. Further, it must carry out its functions openly, while seeking the involvement and contributions of the public, students, and staff in its decision-making processes.

In accordance with these principles, the Executive Board shall seek to achieve the following goals:

- 1. formulate Executive Board policies which best serve the educational interests of each student;
- 2. provide the superintendent with adequate guidelines for implementing Executive Board policies;
- 3. maintain effective communication with the public the Executive Board serves, including staff and students, in order to maintain awareness of attitudes, opinions, desires, and ideas; and
- conduct Executive Board business openly, soliciting and encouraging broad-based involvement by public, students, and staff in the Executive Board's decision-making processes.

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
