## **Executive Board Governance and Operations**

## Executive Board-Superintendent Relationship

The Superintendent shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Governing Board and Executive Board and shall serve as the Secretary of the Executive Board. The Superintendent shall be responsible for the professional leadership and skill necessary to translate the will of the Board into administrative action.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for all aspects of the District's operations and for such duties and powers pertaining thereto as the Executive Board may direct or delegate. The Superintendent may delegate responsibility and the authority necessary to discharge it to other officials and so develop such procedures and regulations, as he or she considers necessary to ensure efficient operation of the District.

The Executive Board will extend to the Superintendent responsibility for implementation of Executive Board policy decisions. In order that the Superintendent may provide effective leadership, the Executive Board will delegate to the Superintendent those powers, which it considers advisable so to do. The Superintendent can expect the Executive Board to support the Superintendent's decisions and administration of the District.
