They will take time to acknowledge academic, athletic, and artistic accomplishments, compete in chalk drawing and dodgeball, and enjoy each other's company before they all disperse for the summer.

The morning kicks off with an Academic Letter and Scholarship Awards ceremony in the school's gymnasium before school from 7:30-8:45 a.m.

From 9:40 a.m. to 1:20 p.m. students will have the option of participating in the Chalk Fest contest, checking out the Davies art show, the technical education open house, or participating in a variety of games and activities throughout the school grounds.

Chalk Fest will feature individual students and teams creating sidewalk chalk masterpieces. The school grounds will be surrounded by colorful pieces of art for students and staff to walk through and enjoy during the day. The winners of Chalk Fest will be announced at the end of the afternoon's all-school pep rally.

The school's art and tech ed students will put their hard work on display. The arts program is hosting an art show, showing off the best art from the year. And the Technical Education department is hosting an open house for the house that the building trades class built, and show off other projects.

During the Chalk Fest and open houses, students and staff will have the option of participating in any of a dozen or more activities. There will be bag toss, spike ball, a dunk tank, board games, and inflatables.

An all-school pep fest will be held in the gym from 1:35-2:30 featuring a Parade of Champions. During the Parade of Champions, all activities and athletics champions will be recognized.

Following the pep rally, students and staff will compete in a students vs. staff dodgeball tournament, lasting through the end of the school day.
