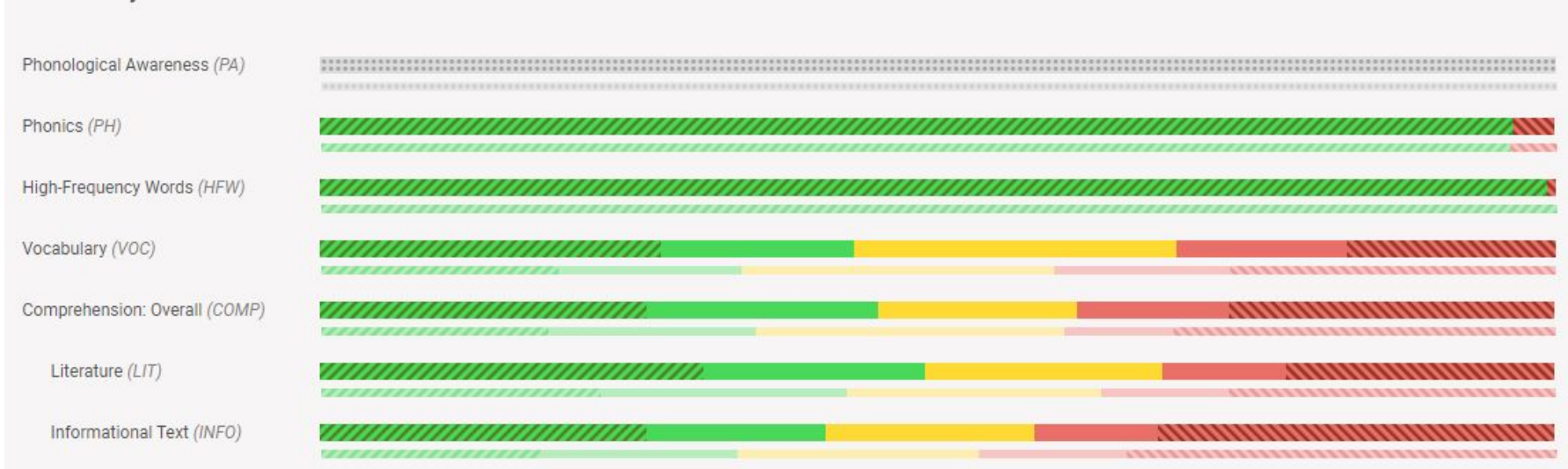

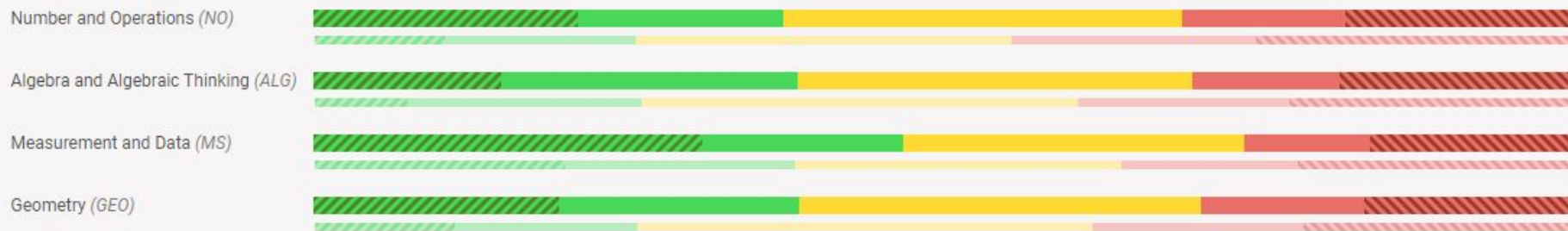

HMS Assessments

Goal 1 – AP1C:T4

- **i-Ready Diagnostic-** This assessment provides diagnostic information in ELA and Math. The data is used to determine skill deficits for individuals and school uses the diagnostic results to set grade level goals and give students a focus for growth. The assessment is currently given three times a school year.
- **i-Ready Standards Mastery-** This assessment is given to determine mastery of grade level standards. HMS also used Standards Mastery Quizzes in both ELA and Math as part of our MAP preparation.
- **Classroom Formative and Summative Assessments-** These assessments are created by teachers to determine mastery of grade level standards.
- **MAP-** State required Assessments- 6th-8th ELA and Math; 8th- Science
- **Eureka Math Assessments-** Middle School uses the K-8 Eureka Math Program and teachers are using Eureka Instructional and Assessment strategies.
