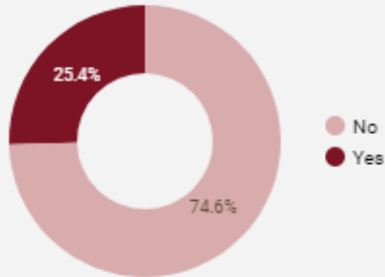
# SCHOOL CLIMATE & BULLYING SURVEY



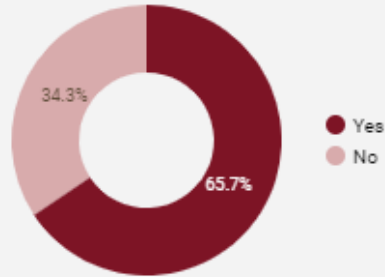
Do you

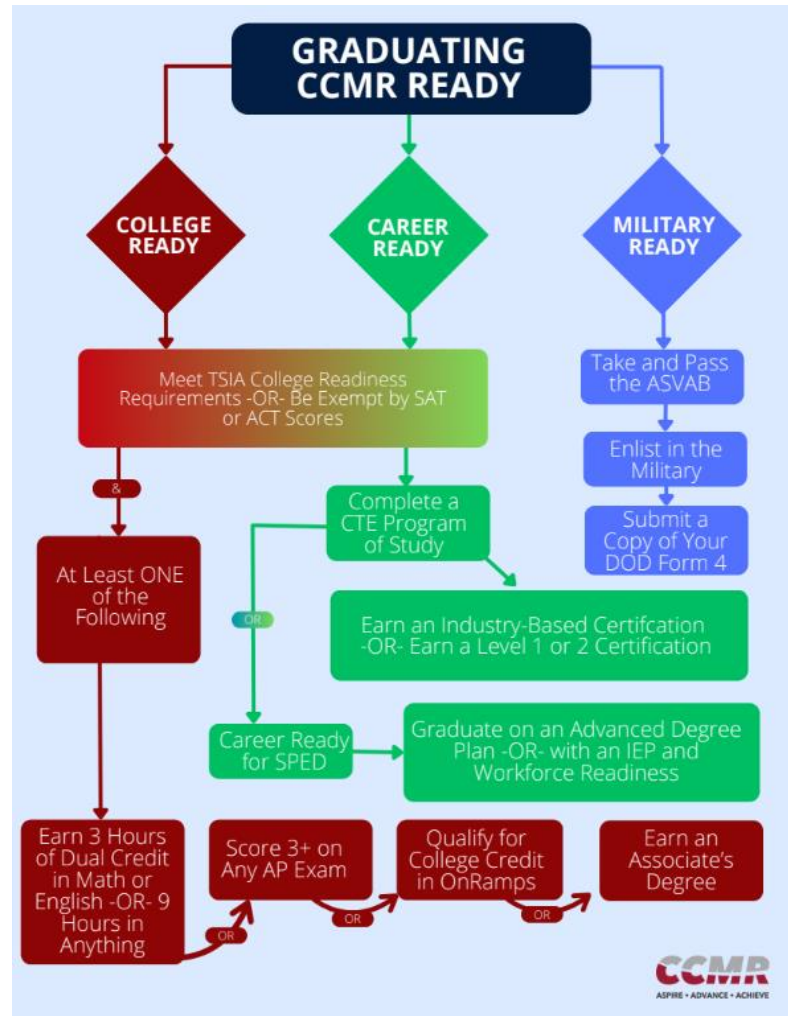
