Year 8 Ultimate Frisbee Championships

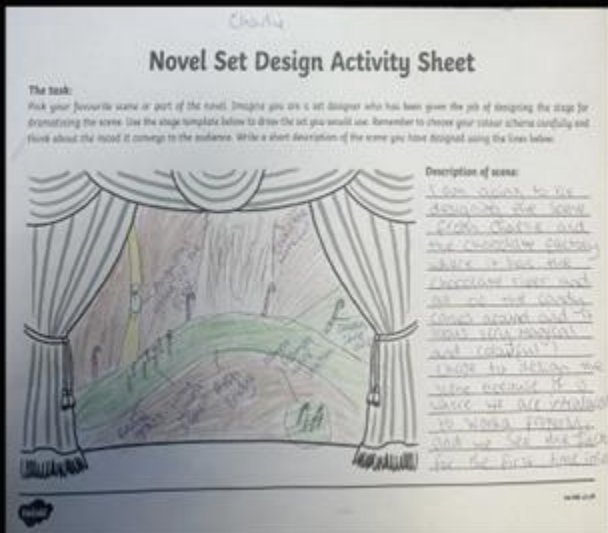
Year 8 students have also been taking part in the ultimate frisbee championships, also displaying excellent levels of leadership and engagement throughout the last 4 weeks.
