 - High density storage was discussed.
 - Go vertical with storage
 - Project storage with windows?
 - Consider blinds need to remain functional.
 - Acoustics – panels currently in space
 - Acoustics currently meet expectations
 - Bigger space
 - Wood Shop
 - Space is used efficiently
 - All the tools get used
 - A lot of windows on south side, lose storage space
 - Users expressed desire to keep windows!!!!
 - Storage
 - Storage for projects is small. Limits what the students can make.
 - Lumber storage OK
 - Need more power outlets. Currently using power strips
 - Open to chord reels.
 - Expressed desire to accommodate current technology
 - Open to furniture with power and data connectivity
 - White board in back doesn't get used
 - Had a smart board that teacher took out.
 - Lighting taken off motion sensor.
 - Poor lighting near lumber storage
 - Shop Equipment
 - CNC router requested
 - Upgrade to industry standard equipment.
