

General Pool Information

How do I get to the Felix V. Festa Pool?

The entrance to the pool is off of Parrott Road, adjacent to the Tennis Courts. From this parking lot, a walkway will lead you directly to the Main Pool Entrance. Once inside the building, access into the pool area can only be obtained through each locker room. Non-pool users are not permitted on the pool deck and must remain in the balcony seating area. This area can be accessed through both sets of stairways or the ramp.

What should I bring to the pool?

Your bathing suit, towel, shoes for the shower and pool deck area, soap/shampoo, and a lock for temporary storage of your belongings. Personal locks are not to be left on lockers and must be removed at the completion of each morning's swim or they will be removed by the District.

What to expect?

The temperature of the pool water normally falls between 77-81 degrees. The air-handling units filter, dehumidify, and heat or cool the air, maintaining a comfortable low humidity, 80-84 degree air temperature with little chlorine odor attributed to the 1000 watt UV Water Purification System in use twenty four hours a day. The dimension of the pool is 50 meters by 60 feet, with a one-meter wide floating bulkhead that can serve to split the pool into any two halves desired. The pool has 16, seven foot wide competitive swim lanes that can facilitate between 1-8 swimmers of the same ability level. The shallow-end of the pool is 3 1/2 feet, gradually deepening to 13 feet. The pool contains approximately 500,000 gallons of chlorinated water which runs on an automated system that electronically measures and balances the pool 24 hours a day. Two, one-meter diving boards and 8 competition starting blocks are situated in the deep-end. The balcony has a seating capacity of approximately 800 spectators. A manual chair lift can be found in the shallow-end of the pool to assist individuals with special needs and portable stairs can be placed in the pool to allow for access during times of 50 meter use.

What are the rules and regulations of the pool?

Safety is our number one priority! All participants are expected to adhere to all facility rules and regulations at all times. A detailed listing of all of the pool rules can be found on our website and are also posted in each locker room and in the main pool area. All participants must provide picture identification upon entry to ensure member status. Morning Community Swim participants must exit the building no later than 8 am, and Evening Community Swim participants must exit the building no later than by 10:15 pm.
