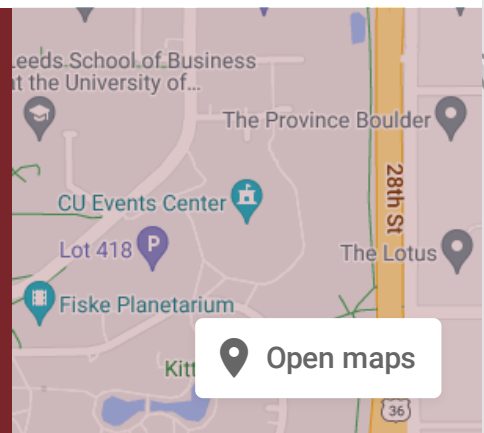

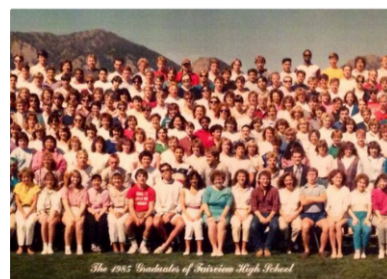

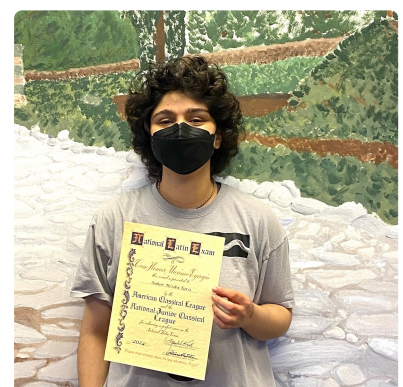

## ACADEMICS

### Student Spring 2024 P/SAT Score Release

Students can begin to access their scores from the Colorado Spring 2024 SAT and PSAT on Thursday, May 16.



Students have several options to access their scores:

- **BigFuture School** – students who took SAT School Day and chose to participate in BigFuture School during exam setup by providing their mobile phone number can access their scores via the BigFuture School mobile app. Students who took PSAT 8/9 did not have the option to participate in BigFuture School.
- **College Board Student Account** – students always have the option to create a College Board account if they would like to access their scores in that way. Most students' scores will match with their accounts and be visible when they navigate to the Student Score Reporting Portal. Some students may need to match their scores with their account.
