## SENIOR CENTER MOVE UPDATE

The School Board recently heard an update on the district's upcoming construction project at the Sunrise Park Middle School building. The Sunrise students and staff wil be moving to the current South Campus building, which will re-open in teh Fall of 2024 as Mariner Middle School.

The Sunrise Park building will then be renovated to house the Senior Center, Community Services and Recreation, District Service Center, Transition Education Center, and Early Childhood Center. This project will be constructed in phases from July 2024 until December 2025.

 Phase 1: July to December 2024 will include district office, board room and storage spaces.

- Phase 2: December 2024 to June 2025 renovations will focus on the Senior Center, gymnasium, kitchen and cafeteria.
- Phase 3: June to December 2025 will complete the project with Early Childhood classrooms and Transition Education Center spaces.

The Senior Center is scheduled to move to the Sunrise location in late-summer 2025. The new space will have three flexible rooms for activities with storage space for supplies, a large screen TV with ceiling speakers, coat/purse and hooks in each room. One room will be set up with extra outlets and sturdier tables. Between two

### WHAT ARE QR CODES

QR codes, short for Quick

Response, are typically black squares arranged in a grid on a white



background... and they are everywhere! In fact, 89 million American mobile phone users scanned a QR code in 2022!

Invented in 1994 by a Japanese company, they were used for for labeling parts, similiar to a bar code. However they had a greater data capacity and their popularity grew.

Over COVID companies used QR Codes for restaruant menus, electronic tickets, to collect






- **Transition Plus** caters to young adults aged 18-22, focusing on post-secondary opportunities, employment, and independent living. Its tailored curriculum and work-based learning opportunities equip students with essential life skills while fostering personal growth.
- **TAPP** provides a structured environment for students with social-emotional barriers, offering a path to graduation through functional academics and the development of employment skills.
- **Project SEARCH**, a year-long internship program, bridges the gap between school and competitive integrated employment for students with disabilities. 
