Administrative Procedure - Safety Dress Code

SEDOL's dress includes appropriate professional attire focused on staff and student safety all year. Staff shall wear appropriate shoes which cover their entire feet. Shoes with non-skid or non-slip soles such as athletic shoes, loafers, boots, flats and leather shoes with closed toes and closed heels are safer options. Leather soles that have a non-skid adhesive grip are also safer. Dangling jewelry and piercings, neckties, drawstrings and long hair that is not tied back can increase the risk of injury. In addition, any leg coverings including shorts and skirts are to be mid-thigh or longer. Clothing should not have tears or be excessively loose as this can increase the risk of injury.
